#### Report Summary

This report marks Lunit's first publication its Sustainability Report. Seeking active communication with its stakeholders, Lunit is fully committed in transparently disclosing the company's aim and performance in sustainable management. From the first publication in June 2024 onwards, each annual Sustainability Report will be published both in Korean and English. We will continue to actively collect stakeholders' opinions through the Sustainability Report and reflect them in our management activities.

#### **Reporting Period and Scope**

This report covers the period from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023, with some activities extending into the first half of 2024. All quantitative achievements include data from the past 3 years for the identification of yearly trends. Economic performances are reported on a consolidated basis, including those of Lunit's headquarters and subsidiaries (Lunit USA, Inc., Lunit China Co., Ltd., Lunit Europe Holdings B.V., Lunit Europe GmbH). Environmental, social, and governance (ESG) performances only include Lunit's headquarters, with few social performances extending to its subsidiaries. We have enhanced stakeholder communication by providing separate annotations where reporting scope and boundaries require attention.

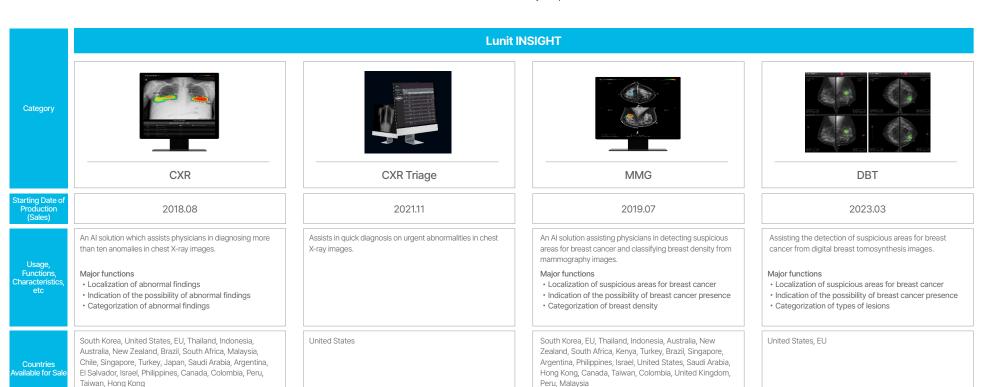


## **Business Overview**

#### **Cancer Screening**

Lunit's flagship products in cancer screening are Lunit INSIGHT CXR and Lunit INSIGHT MMG. Lunit INSIGHT CXR received approval from the South Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety in August 2018 and Lunit IN-SIGHT CXR Triage, which automatically classifies normal and abnormal findings of emergency conditions such as pneumothorax and pleural effusion, received approval from the U.S. FDA in November 2021. Additionally, Lunit INSIGHT MMG obtained approval from the South Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety in July 2019 and received FDA approval in November 2021. In November 2022, both Lunit INSIGHT CXR and Lunit INSIGHT MMG obtained CE certification in accordance with the new European Medical Device Regulation (MDR), proactively addressing future regulatory requirements in the European market. Lunit have introduced Lunit INSIGHT DBT, a new product that assists in detecting suspicious areas of breast cancer from digital breast tomosynthesis images and laid the groundwork for entry into the U.S. market by receiving FDA approval in November 2023.

Lunit INSIGHT's business model consists of two approaches: the Platform model which integrates Al solutions into Picture Archiving and Communication Systems (PACS), and the Modality model which integrates with or embeds into medical imaging devices. Under the Platform model, fees are based on a fixed amount per image analyzed, with regular subscription fees billed monthly or quarterly. The Modality model charges a fixed amount per unit of imaging equipment, along with annual maintenance fees. Lunit consistently collaborates with global manufacturers of X-ray imaging equipments, mammography equipment, and PACS sectors, offering technical products, package configurations, and sales. As a result, Lunit has signed various distribution and sales contracts with international companies such as Fujifilm, GE Healthcare, AGFA, and Philips. With Lunit's global partners holding close to 50% market share in each market, the pace of market dominance and business expansion is expected to accelerate. In fact, as of November 2023, Lunit announced that over 3,000 medical institutions worldwide have already adopted Lunit INSIGHT.

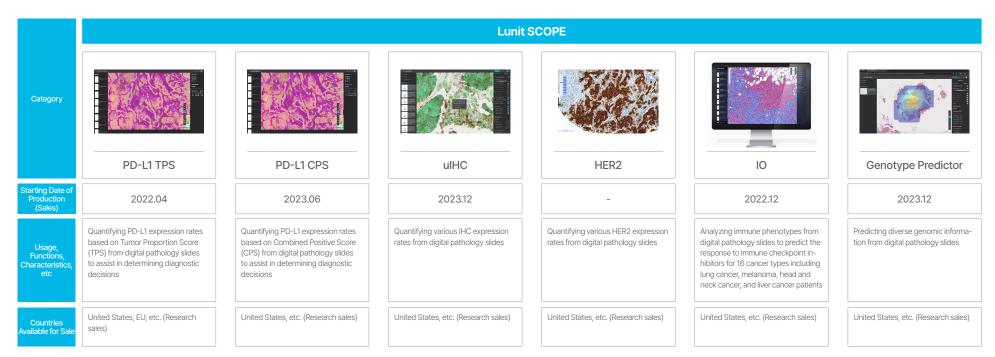

## **Business Overview**

#### Oncology

Lunit's flagship product on Oncology, Lunit SCOPE, is currently being utilized as a biomarker to predict the therapeutic efficacy of immune checkpoint inhibitors by quantifying the expression rates of PD-L1 and TIL. Research and development have been completed for a product capable of predicting the response to immune checkpoint inhibitors for lung cancer and 15 other types of cancer. Lunit has achieved the first research sales during the third quarter of 2023, paving the way for expectations of expanded sales through research contracts with global pharmaceutical companies. Lunit SCOPE has conducted joint research with leading hospitals and research institutions domestically and has been recognized for its technological capabilities through various clinical publications.

In June 2021, Lunit signed a partnership contract with Guardant Health, a world-leading company in the liquid biopsy field, enabling the development of potential biomarkers and utilization of an optimal network for real-world clinical settings. Through collaboration with Guardant Health, Lunit has generated milestone revenues in 2023 in research and development and successfully conducted joint product development and launch. Moreover, we are presenting various studies to expand beyond immune checkpoint inhibitors and include targeted therapies and antibody-drug conjugates (ADCs).

#### **Declaration of Sustainable Management**

Lunit celebrates its 10th founding anniversary under the mission of "Conquer Cancer through AI." Cancer incidence and mortality rates are consistently increasing in our society, even though the expenses for treating cancer are incomparably higher than for other diseases. Lunit is dedicated to achieving better medical accessibility through precise examination and early diagnosis of cancer using AI technology, and providing superior medical services to patients.

Based on past business achievements and research, Lunit has been committed to pursuing future goals of improvements in survival rates and minimizing the financial burdens on patients undergoing cancer treatment. This endeavor not only alleviates the financial burden on individual patients and society, but also contributes to providing optimal medical services for those suffering from cancer. In planning our business strategy for the next 10 years based on sustainable growth, we believe that our environment, governance, and people must always be the utmost priority.

In our first ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) report, we aim to address the current impacts on stakeholders and outline our future strategies and goals, particularly in the focus of achieving greater positive impacts. 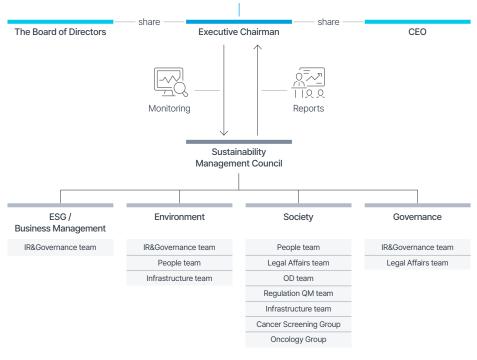

Additionally, critical sustainability issues selected from the annual materiality assessment process will be examined and authorized each year. During the inaugural sustainability management council meeting held in May 2024, the new sustainable development vision and strategy were introduced, and preparations for the 2024 Sustainability Report were initiated, outlining the operational plans for the sustainability management council. The council of Lunit will be systematically operated, continually deliberating on the expansion of sustainable development pursuits.

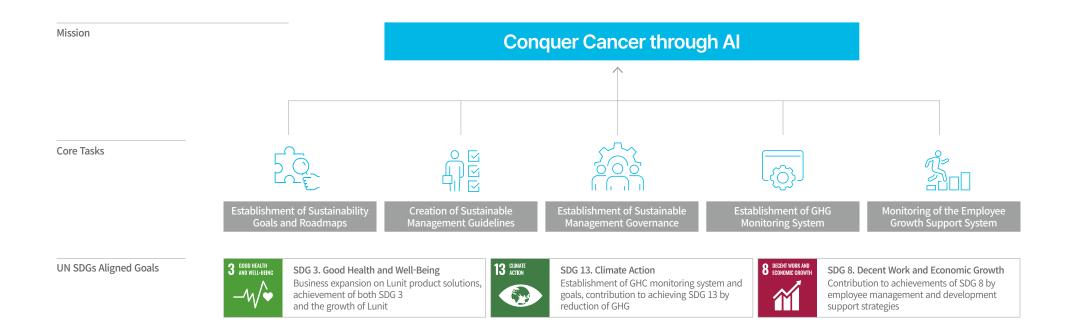

## **Materiality Assessment**

#### **Materiality Assessment Process**

To identify the core issues necessary to promote sustainable management, Lunit has conducted a materiality assessment, applying the double materiality assessment outlined in the EU Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (EU CSRD). Double materiality refers to the impacts of management activities related to sustainable corporate management issues on society (inside-out) and the impacts of the respective sustainable management issues on corporate management activities (outside-in). We have identified 6 priority areas from the 15 issue pools by comprehensively analyzing the interrelated impacts of the corporation and society through a double materiality assessment.

Additionally, criteria such as "Acquisition of Talents and Employee Improvements," "Establishment of ESG Management System," "Corporate Governance," and "Climate Change Response" demonstrate Lunit's desire in promoting sustainable development by internalizing sustainable development within the corporate structure.

## **Human Rights Management**

#### **Human Rights Management System**

#### **Declaration of Human Rights Management**

Since its foundation in 2013 under the mission of 'Conquer Cancer through Al', Lunit has been challenging both the domestic and global markets, thanks to the devotion and enthusiasm of the members. Lunit respects, pursues, and protects the human rights of all stakeholders, including employees, customers, shareholders/ investors, business partners, local communities, and the environment. Furthermore, Lunit is eager to prevent any actual and potential infringement risks of human rights and will always respond quickly to such issues, providing fundamental solutions. As an international corporation, Lunit supports international standards on human rights such as the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights, and International Labor Organization declarations, and will abide by the Acts and subordinate statutes of the Republic of Korea.

#### **Lunit Human Rights Guidelines**

#### 1. Compliance with working conditions and creation of safe working environments

- Lunit strictly manages employee working hours to ensure that the maximum working hours regulated by labor laws in respective countries and regions are not exceeded, and complies with standards related to laws such as working hours, minimum wage, and overtime.
- Lunit respects employee privacy and prohibits any unlawful treatments such as mental and physical coercion, abuse, sexual harassment, threats, and confinement.
- Lunit protects the moral rights, right to health, and right to rest of all employees, and provides a safe and pleasant working environment.

#### 2. Prohibition of forced labor and child labor

- Lunit strictly prohibits child labor under the age of 15, and when unavoidable circumstances require the employment of individuals
  aged 15 to under 18, Lunit follows proper procedures to ensure education opportunities are not restricted and that they do not work
  in environments, including night or overtime shifts, that jeopardize their safety or health.
- $\cdot \text{ Lunit does not allow any form of forced labor against employee's free will, including human trafficking, etc. } \\$

#### 3. Freedom of association and collective bargaining

- Lunit guarantees freedom of association and collective bargaining protected by labor laws of respective countries and regions and will not refuse collective bargaining without legitimate reasons.
- · Lunit ensures that communication opportunities for employees are protected.

#### 4. Anti-Discrimination

 Lunit does not discriminate against employees based on gender, pregnancy, race, ethnicity, nationality, religion, disability, political views, skin color, etc., in the company's recruitment, work processes, promotion, incentives, and training opportunities. Selfdevelopment and training opportunities are granted fairly and assessed and reimbursed based on righteous standards. All employees must respect each other and be treated fairly.

#### 5. Protection of partner and customer human rights

- · The human rights of partners and customers are considered and protected within the same standards of Lunit.
- Lunit puts utmost effort into ensuring customers can safely and conveniently use Lunit's products and services, and therefore will
  quickly and precisely respond to customer requirements for customer satisfaction.

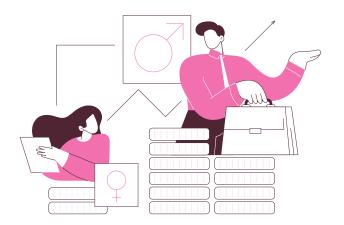

#### **Grievance Process**

Lunit appoints one employee as the member of the grievance committee to address grievance issues and create a working environment where employees can concentrate fully without hardship or difficulty. The appointed personnel is responsible for listening to employee opinions on matters such as internal conflicts, unfair working conditions, infringement on employee rights, and any other personal grievances, and for considering potential improvements. Employees can file grievances with the appointed personnel by completing a grievance request form and can also express their opinions through preferred channels such as verbal communication, In-house messenger program, DMs, or email. All grievances filed through these communication channels will be kept strictly confidential. The appointed member of the grievance committee will notify employees of resolutions and results within 10 days of receiving requests and will provide updates on the status of unresolved requests within the same timeframe. If necessary, the appointed member of the grievance committee may bring issues to the attention of the Lunitian Committee (Joint labor-management conference).

#### **Robust Labor-Management Relations**

#### A Joint labor-Management Conference

Lunit respects the freedom of association and collective bargaining as stipulated in the Convention of the International Labor Organization and Korean labor law. To safeguard these rights, a joint labor-management conference has been established to foster organizational culture and address grievances. The conference comprises up to 5 user members and labor council members and is typically held quarterly. Additionally, adhoc conferences may be convened when representatives of labor and management raise agenda items. The conference chairman notifies members of the conference of the date, location, and agenda at least 7 days in advance, and any agenda items agreed upon during the conference are promptly implemented and communicated to all employees through appropriate channels. Lunit is committed to fostering open communication and cooperation between labor and management to resolve internal disputes and enhance the working environment.

#### **Talent Acquisition**

#### **Transparent Recruitment Process**

Lunit establishes its recruitment policies to ensure an equitable hiring process for both newly hired and experienced candidates. The required number of new employees for each team and department is determined, and a pool of applicants is gathered through job postings, references, and recommendations before the screening of application documents and interviews. Interviewers assess applicants using rubrics designed for fairness and optimal recruitment, and additional tasks such as presentations may be assigned to evaluate suitability for the company's culture code when necessary. 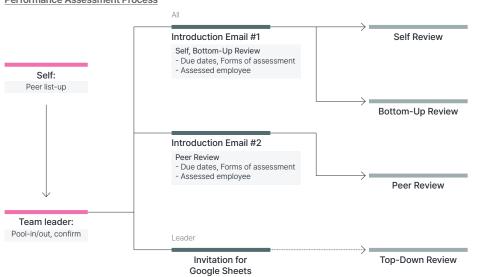

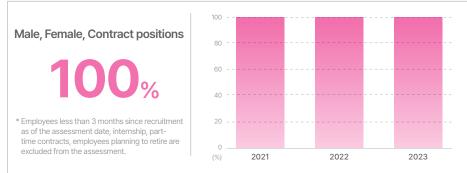
#### Long-Term Performance Assessment and Feedback Process

Lunit conducts performance assessments biannually for all permanent positions, while temporary positions are assessed based on the contracted period. These assessments utilize various tools such as Airtable forms, Google surveys, and Google Sheets across different sectors. The assessment criteria include primary duties, leadership, cooperation, strengths, and weaknesses, which are evaluated based on the organization's culture and values. To ensure fairness, a 360-degree feedback system is employed, incorporating self-assessment, bottom-up feedback, peer evaluation, and top-down feedback. Review and feedback sessions are facilitated by leaders, with the opportunity for input from the next level of authority if needed. Employees receive detailed written comments on their assessment results, which emphasize on the recognition of performance and areas for improvement rather than just scores or grades. Furthermore, feedback on the assessment process is gathered through satisfaction surveys to drive continuous improvement. Through systematic performance assessment and feedback collection, Lunit enhances organizational performance and employee satisfaction by leveraging the diverse potentials and strengths of its workforce.

#### Reasonable Compensation System

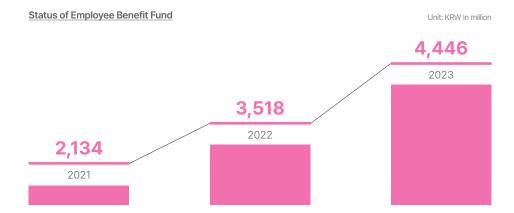

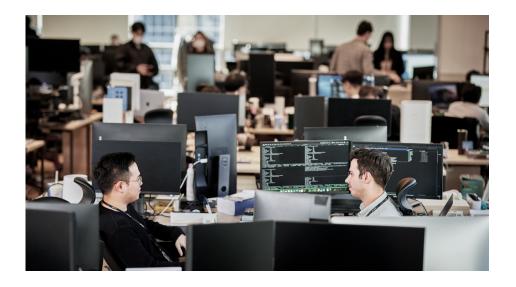

Lunit is actively expanding its global strategic partnerships to advance sustainable development and enhance healthcare accessibility worldwide. Our Al diagnostic solution, Lunit INSIGHT CXR, which covers 10 lung diseases, has been developed and provided to leading global X-ray manufacturers including AGFA, FujiFilm, GE Healthcare, Philips, among others. Recently, we have also entered into a partnership agreement with Samsung Electronics, a prominent market leader in Korea.

Furthermore, Lunit INSIGHT MMG, our Al diagnostic solution for breast cancer, has garnered attention for its technological prowess in alleviating the shortage of medical experts in many countries. This is particularly crucial given the complexity of breast cancer screening and diagnosis, which typically requires high levels of expertise beyond standard X-ray images.

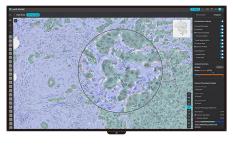
In order to globally compete in the Digital Breast Tomosynthesis sector, our newly CE and FDA approved product, Lunit INSIGHT DBT solutions, has succeeded in demonstrating superior AI reading performances in more complex 3D images than the already advanced 2D screening technology of INSIGHT MMG. 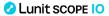


#### **Lunit SCOPE Partnership**

Through relentless efforts in earning global recognition and certification, authentication for medical devices, Lunit plays a pivotal role in enhancing medical infrastructure as it has achieved several significant milestones such as signing distribution contracts with over 3,500 medical institutions and healthcare providers across the globe in the US, Southeast Asia, and the Middle East.

In the Middle East, Lunit has solidified its presence by offering Al screening solutions for breast cancer to the Dubai Academic Health Corporation, in collaboration with strategic partner Agfa Healthcare. Additionally, Lunit has installed Lunit INSIGHT CXR and Lunit INSIGHT MMG in the world's largest public virtual hospital of the Saudi Arabian Ministry of Health (MoH), enabling comprehensive cancer and tuberculosis screening programs for over 170 public and private virtual hospitals throughout Saudi Arabia.

In Singapore, Lunit has provided Lunit INSIGHT CXR to Radlink, the largest imaging center in the country, and integrated the product into the nation's AI platform. Furthermore, Lunit secured an exclusive provider position for Al solutions in the BSNSW program bidding by the state government of New South Wales, Australia, marking its first selection for a nation-level cancer screening project globally, valid until 2029.

Back in Korea, Lunit participated in a private-led e-government project and offered pilot services of Lunit INSIGHT CXR to 29 public health centers to support professional manpower and enhance medical services. During the post-project period, Lunit continues to support select public health centers through commercial contracts for lung disease screening services. Lunit INSIGHT CXR has also been recognized as the first innovative Korean medical technology through integrated reviews and assessments by the Korean Ministry of Health and Welfare, facilitating selective and non-beneficial health insurance compensation for suspected patients over the age of 14 with thoracic-cardiovascular diseases.

#### **Price Accessibility and Medical Supports**

Lunit operates a designated C-level pricing committee comprising stakeholders such as customers within and outside Korea, as well as medical professionals. This committee deliberates on pricing policies for products, diagnostic costs, pricing limits, weighted averages for price increases, and more. Additionally, Lunit offers free screening services as part of a patient support program aimed at individuals who may not have sufficient purchasing capabilities.



Covid 19 diagnosis support

Lunit supplied Lunit INSIGHT CXR, an Al-assisted detection tool for lung diseases, to medical institutions in regions heavily affected by COVID-19, including France, Portugal, Italy, Brazil, Panama, Indonesia, Thailand, and others, along with comprehensive product instructions.



Assistance in medically deprivileged regions

Lunit extends support to medical services, including tuberculosis check-ups, in developing countries with limited medical infrastructure like Nepal and Cambodia, by providing the company's products such as Lunit INSIGHT CXR. In Korea, Lunit INSIGHT CXR is utilized for the Tuberculosis diagnosis program for seniors in a contracted project with the Korea Tuberculosis Association, aiding in the diagnosis of new patients with such disease.



Introducing Al solutions for the military

Lunit provides chest X-ray screening for military personnel regarding infectious and emergency diseases by participating in the government AI convergence project, AI+X. Lunit INSIGHT CXR has completed military data learning and has been deployed in medical military units in remote tactical areas and military hospitals. Additionally, support has been extended to units deployed in countries such as Uzbekistan.

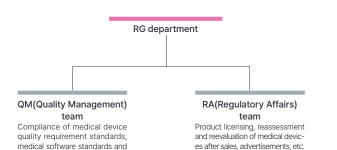

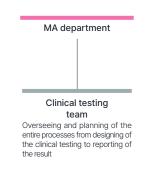

As a SaMD (Software as a Medical Device) company, Lunit prioritizes customer satisfaction and safety above all else, striving for prosperity and sustainable development. The company's quality control system and processes are intricately designed to ensure the safety and quality of its products.

Lunit has obtained ISO 13485 and GMP authorization for all production facilities, underscoring the robust credibility of its production processes and product quality. Moreover, Lunit INSIGHT products have been cleared by the EU MDR and UKCA CE, marking a significant milestone as the first case in the software medical device market in Pan-Pacific and Asian regions.

Lunit systematically operates and maintains its quality control system within the RG/MA department. Additionally, various quality data, including sales figures, guest feedback, customer dissatisfaction, and CAPA (Corrective and Preventive Action) status, are meticulously analyzed through quarterly quality data summaries. This proactive approach ensures continuous improvement in service quality and customer satisfaction.





#### **Quality Test Management**

Lunit has developed and implemented an inspection system during the production and shipping stages to ensure the quality and safety of its products. This system complies to stringent regulations set forth by domestic and international regulatory agencies. The QM(Quality Management) team meticulously handles the testing results by examining them in detail to uphold the company's commitment to delivering products of the highest quality and safety standards.

#### Responsible Marketing

The RA(Regulatory Affairs) team at Lunit is responsible for ensuring the company's marketing and advertising practices compliant to both domestic and international laws and regulations. The marketing team verifies that all advertised products comply with the requirements of the Medical Appliances Act and align with the intended use and contents specified in the product license. This ensures that Lunit's marketing efforts are credible, responsible, and compliant with industry standards.

#### **Quality Control Trainings**

Lunit has designated individuals responsible for overseeing the internal development and production processes of its products to ensure the maintenance of high standards in sustainable quality management. Annual training sessions on production processes and quality qualifications are conducted to keep these individuals up to date. Regular exams and assessments are administered to assess their knowledge, and those who pass all courses are granted audit permissions. #### Research and Patents

To demonstrate the superiority of our products and technologies over competitors, we are actively publishing journals and applying for patents based on medical trials conducted in leading medical institutions both in Korea and abroad. For instance, in October 2023, Lunit published the results of applying Lunit SCOPE, an Al-based diagnostic tool as an exploratory biomarker in a phase 3 clinical trial study of immunotherapy-chemotherapy for non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) patients with gene mutations in the prestigious international journal of Oncology, the Journal of Clinical Oncology (JCO). In June 2023, Lunit participated in CVPR 2023, the most prestigious conference in the field of AI, and presented two AI papers specialized in the field of pathology.

A prospective study led by Dr. Fredrik Strand of the Royal Institute of Karolinska Institute in Sweden, published in the international journal Lancet Digital Health, found that the combination of Lunit Al and a single human physician resulted in a higher CDR (Cancer Detection Rate) and lower recall rate—patients being called back for a second opinion—than when read by two human physicians. Based on these findings, Capio St. Göran Hospital in Stockholm, Sweden, implemented Lunit INSIGHT MMG, becoming the first hospital in Europe to use an Al solution to replace one of its doctors when performing breast cancer screenings.

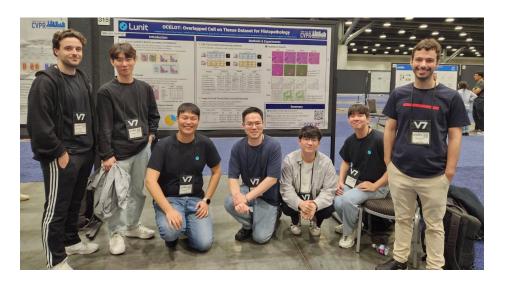
In September 2023, Lunit was successfully granted a patent for methods and devices providing immunophenotype information on medical slide images. This patent is closely related to Lunit SCOPE and we plan to utilize it to gain exclusive rights to our imaging biomarker solution technology for cancer treatments not only in Korea but also in the US, Europe, Japan, and potentially other countries. #### **Partnership Management Process**

#### Selection of Partners

Lunit diligently oversees the assessment process of partnership to ensure product quality and safety. Partnership proposals are meticulously reviewed and segregated based on their merits and minimum requirements, and subject to initial evaluation of the partners based on the risk and partnership classification table delivered with the request.

Upon final approval by the relevant authority, the selected partners are listed and separately managed in the partnership management ledger. Our partner selecting process allows us to thoroughly select and manage partners to maintain stable cooperation and provide better products and services to our customers.



#### **Partner Assessment**

In accordance with the Partnership and Purchase Management Procedure, Lunit periodically evaluates and manages both the financial and non-financial quality levels of partners in consideration of their risk levels. Various criteria such as financial health, network, quality, and human resource management are evaluated regularly, while additional assessments are assigned as needed based on partner risk levels and compliance standard.

Detailed evaluation standards are determined using partner scorecards, and grades according to their risk levels. Through these processes, Lunit ensures and maintains stable partnerships to safeguard customer safety and product quality.

Partners that do not meet the standards are required to implement corrective measures for quality improvement. This may involve establishing quality maintenance plans, implementing and maintaining measurement systems, statistical production control, reinforcing assessments and their results, establishing corrective actions, and making ongoing efforts to improve product quality and enhance partnership credibility.

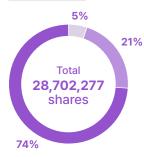

#### **Protection of Shareholder Rights**

Lunit upholds shareholder rights and ensures equal treatment for all shareholders, including minor and foreign shareholders, in accordance with relevant constitutional provisions and the Articles of Incorporation. Shareholders are notified of general meetings at least two weeks in advance, allowing them time to review the agenda and exercise their voting rights. The notification includes comprehensive details on each agenda item, along with disclosures of previous business reports and audit reports to provide shareholders with insight into the company's performance and status. Proxy voting rights are granted to shareholders unable to attend the meeting, facilitating convenient exercise of voting rights. Additionally, an electronic voting system have been implemented to maximize shareholder participation. Going forward, we plan to continue to accelerate shareholder-friendly management through various policy initiatives.

#### **Efforts Towards Communication**

Lunit makes various efforts to strengthen transparent and effective communication with all stakeholders, including shareholders. In 2023, Lunit held 232 investor relations (IR) meetings and 264 IR events for institutional investors worldwide, sharing key business status, vision, products and services, global market positioning, roadmaps, and financial performance. To deliver clear and concise information to shareholders and investors, Lunit publishes quarterly IR letters and offers additional commentary when necessary for press releases. Moreover, Lunit maintains active communication channels, such as SNS (Telegram) channels, to engage with shareholders. Major business achievements and corporate updates are disclosed through annual, semi-annual, and quarterly publications, providing shareholders with comprehensive and timely information.

#### **Board Composition and Activities**

#### The Board of Director

The Current Board of Directors

Lunit's Board of Directors consists of 2 inside directors, 3 outside directors, and 1 non-executive director. Given the decision-making authority, the board oversees critical management affairs stipulated by pertinent laws or Articles of Incorporation, delegated mandates from the general meetings of shareholders, fundamental management principles. Additionally, the board supervises the directors' execution of duties. As the highest decision-making entity, the board holds the authority to appoint the CEO.

#### The Independence of the Board

Lunit ensures transparency and accountability of the BOD by separating the roles of Chairman and CEO to strengthen fair and independent decision-making. Furthermore, Lunit complies with corporate law by appointing more than a quarter of the board members as outside directors, enabling the board to function independently from management and significant shareholders. Lunit appoints outside directors based on their qualifications, ensuring fairness and independence. Lunit prioritizes on the diversity of the Board, considering factors such as age, gender, race, and nationality without discrimination. Currently, the board comprises 1 American and 2 female directors, with further plans to progressively enhance diversity in the future.

#### **Prevention of Conflict of Interest**

To ensure independent and transparent board operations, Lunit adheres to the regulations on the board operation stating that "The Directors with specific conflicts of interest regarding the board resolutions cannot exercise voting rights." This practice safeguards against any undue benefits or disadvantages for individuals involved. Additionally, a transaction limit policy ensures clarity and transparency in the decision-making and execution of the company's business activities by stipulating the requirements for transactions with all stakeholders, including directors and related parties. Based on these regulations, the board of directors determine the independence and appropriateness of stakeholder transactions and decides on the execution and scale of the transactions.

# Appointment and Operation of the Directors

All directors at Lunit are appointed via resolutions at the general shareholders' meeting, following the guidelines outlined in the Articles of Incorporation. When appointing two or more directors, the concentrated voting system stipulated by the Commercial Code is not applied. Major decisions are deliberated and decided upon by the board of directors, which serves as the highest decision-making body. In 2023, Lunit held a total of 6 board meetings and deliberated on and resolved 14 agendas.

# Expertise of the Board of Directors and Opportunities for Management Participation

Lunit's board of directors consists of members with professional experience in various fields such as finance, accounting, management, law, and biotechnology to enable rational decision-making amid the dynamic landscape of the IT healthcare industry. Lunit also appoints directors with various knowledge and practical experience in areas such as business strategy and global operations. Regular training sessions are conducted to bolster the board's capabilities and expertise, with a recent focus on sustainability enhancement in May 2024. In order to maintain the board's competence and expertise, Lunit regularly encourage professional training.

Lunit also supports its outside directors in fulfilling their duties effectively within the board such as providing agenda information in advance for thorough review before meetings or offering separate briefings when needed. Furthermore, Lunit regularly provides information on internal management issues to ensure directors are well-informed.

#### **Audit Committee**

In 2024, Lunit established a new audit committee to uphold transparency and fairness in accounting operations and overall company practices. Composed of over two-thirds of independent outside directors, the committee ensures independence and transparency. These outside directors examine whether they fall under disqualifying criteria outlined in the Commercial Act or their relationships with the company and major shareholders are scrutinized. To bolster the audit committee's expertise, the board of directors nominates candidates with a comprehensive understanding of corporate management, industry knowledge, and practical experience in accounting, finance, economics, and related fields. Additionally, at least one committee member is a financial or accounting expert.

Annual training sessions on internal accounting are conducted for audit committee members to enhance their expertise. The appointment of the external auditor by the committee ensures legitimate and practical independence. Lunit prohibits additional compensation for audit committee members beyond their duties to maintain independent audits free from management and major shareholders' influence. Compensation for audit committee members is determined based on their time, effort invested in performing duties, and the level of legal responsibility associated with their tasks as directors.

# Performance and Compensation System

This compensation system supports the management's effort in increasing the company's long-term profits, value, and efficient operation considering shareholders' interests. Lunit endeavors to incentivize the competence and performance of management through a transparent and fair compensation system, contributing to the competitiveness and value enhancement of the company.

### **Transparent Disclosure of Compensation**

Lunit ensures equitable compensation for inside and outside directors according to guidelines established by the Compensation Committee, and the total compensation amount for key board members is transparently disclosed in the company's annual report. For registered directors, the compensation level is determined within the approved amount in the general meeting of the shareholders, considering their position and duties.

# **Integrated Risk Management**

#### Risk Management Governance

Lunit has implemented a robust monitoring and management system to reinforce risk management and postmanagement efforts. The designated committees for risk management are the board of directors and the audit committee. Lunit conducts Quarterly reporting on key business decisions and associated risks, along with corresponding response measures and additional meetings as needed.

Lunit's Audit Committee performs independent risk management monitoring and ensures independence and active participation by specifying relevant duties and authorities in accordance with the Audit Committee Regulations.

The Audit Committee convenes at least once every quarter to review the performance of risk management monitoring which covers internal assessments, matters requiring pre-reviews, and compliance checks. Regular communication with external auditors occurs at least once a quarter, and when necessary, the committee recommends the external auditors, heads of internal audit departments, financial executives, and management to participate. Minutes are recorded in all meetings and approved by the audit committee members.

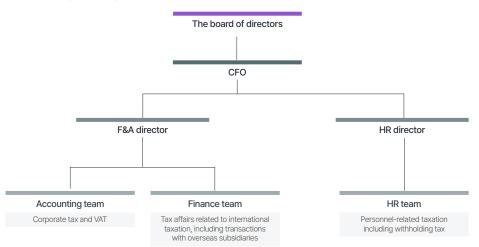

### **Tax Management Organization**

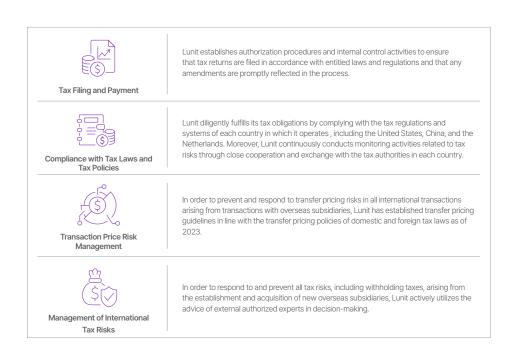

# **Data Security**

#### Information Security Declaration

Lunit recognizes the importance of protecting key information assets such as patient imaging data and information system infrastructure for the ongoing development through communication with patients and client organizations. To securely protect and maintain these key information assets, Lunit has established and operates an information security management system. Through such system, Lunit strives to achieve the following objectives.

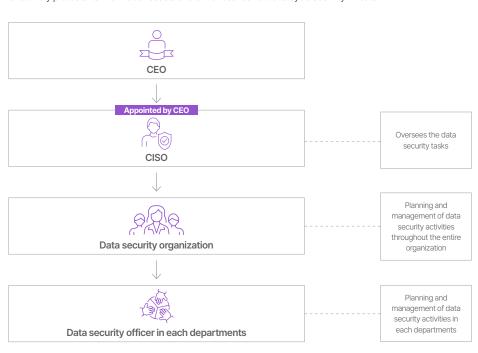
- · Safeguarding key information assets of company such as customer personal data and information system infrastructure.
- · Utilizing all information and information assets only within the scope necessary for performing duties.
- Prohibiting the use or disclosure of all information and information assets unrelated to business.
- Protecting all information and information assets from unauthorized access and alterations.
- · Compliance with regulations related to personal information and information security.

#### Information Security Regulations and Policies

Lunit's information security policy guidelines have been established for all members, including permanent and temporary employees, dispatched workers, visitors, and external company employees. The information security policy and regulations are reviewed proactively by the Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) and the information security organization, confirming the validity of the policy at least once a year and taking necessary actions as needed. Amendments to the policy and regulations are subject to review by a committee after consultation and require approval from the CEO. The policy is easily accessible to all members, while the management system is continuously monitored and updated. Appropriate measures are taken for identified vulnerabilities, communicated to relevant members, and consulted for expert advice. The CISO and the information security organization annually conduct both reviews to ensure the adequacy of the management system, and audits of information security policies and systems to protect the company's information assets safely meeting the standards required for certification.

# Information Security Organization

Lunit has established an information security organization to systematically manage information security. First, the Chief Information Security Officer (CISO) oversees all information security tasks. The CISO manages comprehensive information security tasks such as establishing information security regulations, forming and operating the information security committee, conducting risk analysis and management, and managing security incident response and recovery. Additionally, each department designates an officer and a designee for management and operation of information security. These individuals have the appropriate skills to plan and manage information security activities across the organization, with clear responsibilities and roles defined. The key role of the information security organization is to operate the information security committee. This committee has been established to efficiently manage the company's information security management and make policy decisions on key matters. The information security committee deliberates on and resolves major security issues, formulates and implements strategies and policies necessary for information security. Through this, the company effectively protects its information assets and enhances resilience to cybersecurity threats.

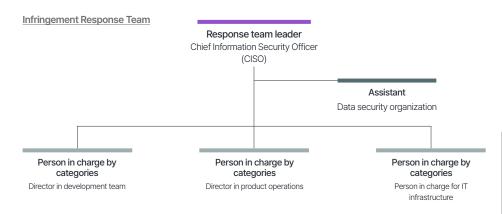

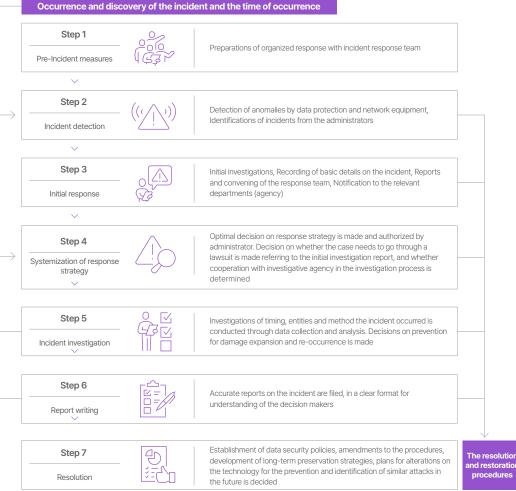

# Data Breach and Incident Response System

Lunit has a comprehensive security incident management system in place to ensure swift and effective responses to data breach incidents. The potential types of security incidents are defined in advance and security incident prevention activities such as simulated drills and training are conducted. In case of a security incident, we take measures such as forming a security incident response team and establishing an initial response plan. Additionally, prompt and effective responses are made through secure management of evidence. After an incident occurs, we take measures such as establishing a post-incident management plan, educating and informing employees of the contents, and periodically reviewing and revising security incident response procedures. Furthermore, to strengthen our response to cyber-attacks, we take measures such as conducting our own response drills, organizing an emergency response team, and reporting to relevant authorities for assistance, if necessary. Through these measures, Lunit effectively protects its information assets by responding promptly and appropriately to data breaches and incidents.

# Information Security Training

Lunit operates a robust training and management system for information security. All employees, employees of external companies, and project personnel are required to sign a security pledge to maintain the security of the company's information assets to ensure compliance with security-related regulations. Lunit establishes and implements education plans to enhance information security awareness and carry out operational tasks effectively. These plans target all employees, including employees of subsidiaries and temporary workers. The content of the training is tailored to the job characteristics of the trainees, with records kept, and evaluation results reflected in future training plans. New hires undergo security training and sign a security pledge for the importance of information security. Upon resignation, interviews are conducted to obtain a signed security pledge and manage access to information assets and information systems. Through these efforts, Lunit promotes awareness and practices of information security and continuously strengthens capabilities to prevent security incidents.

# Reinforced Information Security

Lunit has strengthened information security by obtaining ISO 27001 international standard certification and the Cyber Essentials (Plus) Certificate of Assurance. Additionally, Lunit has implemented data loss prevention (DLP), network access control (NAC), and antivirus/antimalware solutions for detecting malicious codes and software on employees' devices to enhance security levels.



### **Protection of Personal Data**

### Personal Data Management Policy

Lunit has established and implemented policies related to personal data management for the protection of personal information, which apply to all employees and staff of affiliated companies. Lunit minimizes the collection of personal information to the extent necessary to achieve specific purposes and chooses methods to minimize infringement upon the privacy of data subjects, even when processing personal information within the scope required for the processing purpose. Handling sensitive information such as health information, sexual activity, or sexual orientation is generally prohibited, and personal information deemed to pose a high risk of leakage is secured through encryption and anonymization. Additionally, access controls are implemented to prevent illegal access and security breaches in information and communication networks. Lunit does not use or provide collected and stored personal information for purposes other than service provision, nor does it rent or sell it to third parties. Furthermore, personal information is deleted without delay due to the expiration of retention periods, achievement of processing purposes, or expiration of the processing period for pseudonymous information.

### **Ensuring the Rights of Data Subjects**

Individuals whose personal information is processed by Lunit have the right to obtain confirmation from the data controller as to whether their personal data is being processed, and if so, to access that information. Additionally, individuals have the right to supplement incomplete personal information or provide additional statements based on the purpose of personal data processing. If inaccurate personal data is processed, individuals have the right to request rectification, and they may also request deletion without undue delay. Data controllers must respond promptly to such requests and ensure the rights of the data subjects are upheld.

# Personal Data Protection Organization and Trainings

Lunit operates a personal data protection system centered around the Personal Data Protection Officer (DPO) which ensure systematic management of data protection tasks. Supporting staff members assist the DPO to ensure smooth operations. Each department handles personal data processing through its designated personal data handling department and receive relevant training and guidance. The data protection officer establishes a personal data protection education plan and conducts training sessions for data handlers at least once a year. The education program covers relevant laws, regulations, internal policies, protection measures, and undergoes continuous improvement through evaluation processes. Additionally, a Personal Data Protection Committee has been established to enhance the company's personal data management system and address personal data-related issues. Through these measures, Lunit continually improves to ensure the protection of individuals' personal information.

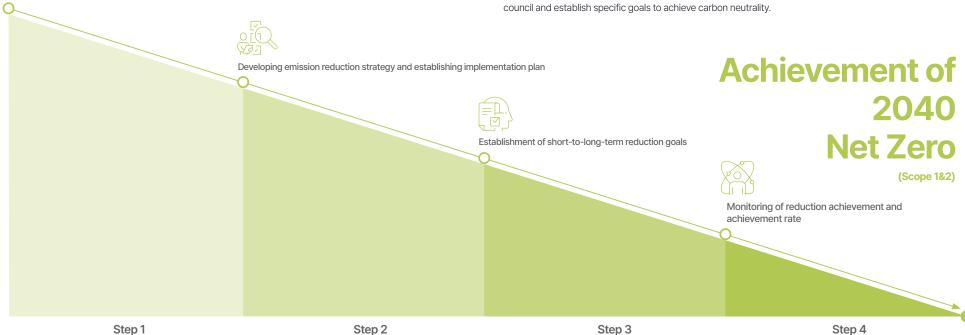
#### Scope 1&2 2040 Net Zero

Major countries around the world, including Korea have declared carbon neutrality by 2050. As a result, the role of companies in reducing greenhouse gas emissions is more emphasized than ever. In response, Lunit is planning a medium to long-term roadmap aiming to achieve carbon neutrality by 2040 for greenhouse gases corresponding to scopes 1 and 2, considering the nature of Al-based environmentally friendly businesses.

### Climate Change Response Strategy

Lunit plans to develop climate change response strategies to effectively address the challenges of climate change and conduct related activities. Specifically, Lunit plans to gradually transition the energy to renewable energy through Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions.

#### **Climate Change Response Organization**

The risks and opportunities arising from climate change can significantly impact a company's profitability and growth. Recognizing this fact, Lunit's management has decided to implement policies regarding energy management and greenhouse gas reduction to ensure the company fulfills its responsibility towards climate change. In 2024, Lunit organized its first sustainability management council and held discussions to devise climate change response strategies for achieving net zero emissions. Going forward, Lunit will conduct analyses on the risks and opportunities associated with climate change within the sustainability management council and establish specific goals to achieve carbon neutrality.

# **Greenhouse Gas Emission Management**

#### **Establishment of Greenhouse Gas Management System**

Lunit currently manages greenhouse gas emissions from two sources within its operations: emissions resulting from the consumption of energy by vehicles, including road vehicles (Scope 1), and emissions from the electricity consumption in the company's office premises (Scope 2). With the increasing global sense of urgency surrounding climate change, response to climate change, particularly among healthcare companies, is becoming increasingly important. In response, Lunit plans to regularly measure and disclose carbon emissions data, despite not being subject to carbon emission regulations such as emissions trading schemes or carbon emission target management. Furthermore, to further reduce greenhouse gas emissions, Lunit plans to prioritize the establishment of an inventory system that identifies greenhouse gas emissions from all revenue-generating business sites. This initiative marks the initial step towards Lunit's goal of achieving carbon neutrality by 2040.

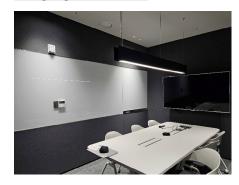
